Footnotes

FLYING MARINE was in tight into the first turn but got clear and was well positioned to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then eased to the rail where there was plenty of room, rallied when set down and gamely tagged BI TOMORROW late. BI TOMORROW contested the pace while four wide to the backstretch, dueled to the second turn, was off the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then could not hold off the winner in the final yards. MARY'S APP was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, was asked for his best leaving the three eighths, raced four deep to the stretch but failed to offer the needed response. ALL THE MAGIC was in tight behind UNUSUAL MYSTERY into the first turn, stalked the leaders to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch but finished evenly late. KERN RIVER saved ground to the backstretch, tried to rally while outside a foe on the second turn but failed to threaten. MIDNIGHT CON angled in early to save some ground while showing no speed, trailed to the second turn, was four wide to the stretch then could only pick off rivals late. ST PIRRRAN was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch but also finished evenly. PICK ONE FOR ME was outsprinted to the backstretch, settled to the second turn then could not muster a late response. TOPAKI saved ground early, was roused inside on the second turn and closed some ground to the stretch but faded in the drive. UNUSUAL MYSTERY was on the pace for six furlongs then tired and stopped in mid stretch.
