TONZATROUBLE was well placed to the turn, rallied four wide to the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch and held under steady urging. PEPPERED PRO pressed the pace early, was boxed behind rivals on the turn and lost position, finally got off the rail once in the stretch and finished in a good rally. MIND THE LADIES had no speed, came two wide to the stretch then swung out and finished willingly. GOLD STAR tracked the pace to the turn, was fanned four wide and outkicked to mid stretch then could not make an impact late. RAINGEAR tracked the leaders to the turn, rallied three wide to move up and engage for the lead into the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. AFLEET DEAL was fractious in the gate, had no speed, raced three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. FIRSTCLASSTRAVELER was bumped by MTN RANCH WILLY at the start, recovered then was caught in traffic leaving the five eighths pole, took up and lost position, raced three wide on the turn but failed to mount the needed rally. MTN RANCH WILLY broke out and bumped FIRSTCLASSTRAVELER at the start then was not a factor. COMPROMISING TXT was hustled to the front, set a pressured pace while off the rail to the stretch then stopped.
