WILD RULER had no speed, trailed to the second turn, rallied three then four wide to the stretch, responded in the drive and closed fast to wear down DOLPHIN SHORTS late. DOLPHIN SHORTS set the pace to the second turn, turned back SURF QUEEN in upper stretch, edged away again to mid stretch but could not stall the winner. BOBBYLOUIE stalked the pace to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch then could not make an impact while best of the rest. RODSTER was settled to the half, got fanned out five wide to the stretch and lacked the needed late response. SURF QUEEN pressed the pace to the second turn, moved alongside the runnerup to duel into the stretch then was outkicked to mid stretch and weakened. CANALASSO was three wide early, settled to the second turn, raced off the rail to the stretch but did not rally. LADY LIZ saved ground to no avail.
