Footnotes

DEVIL'S CHOIR attended the pace to the turn, moved to the front in hand three wide to the stretch, kicked away to mid stretch then was kept busy through the final sixteenth. NINA'S HOPE dueled between rivals to the turn, was outrun by the winner nearing the quarter pole, shifted outside of that one into the stretch then could not make an impact while besting the rest. AWESOME VARIETY brushed repeatedly with PRINCESS OILLY in opening furlong, settled nearing the half mile pole, raced two then three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. PEPPY CAT pulled early to be a pace factor inside to the half mile pole, had to steady when trying to get out from the seven sixteenths to the three eighths, saved ground to the stretch but lacked a response in the final furlong. IRISH SURFER GIRL had no speed, raced three wide to the stretch but did not threaten. PRINCESS OILLY brushed repeatedly with AWESOME VARIETY in the opening furlong, dropped back quickly on the turn and stopped in the stretch.
