APPEALING RESUME stalked the pace early, was crowded inside and took back leaving the half mile pole, shifted three wide then swung five wide into the stretch, closed with a rush in the final sixteenth and was up in time. POSSE'S PRINCESS was outsprinted early, bid four wide on the turn, rallied to the front into the stretch, remained clear to deep stretch then could not stall the winner. OLD WAY tracked the leaders to the turn, came three then four wide to the stretch and was gaining ground belatedly. PRIVATE PARK contested the pace to the turn, drifted out leaving the quarter pole then was collared by the winner and lugged out while giving way. NO CREAM OR SUGAR tracked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but weakened in the lane. LUCK BE A LILY attended the pace to the turn, was outkicked by PRIVATE PARK to mid turn then had to steady sharply when cut off by that one leaving the quarter pole and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident leaving the quarter pole involving PRIVATE PARK and LUCK BE A LILY and disqualified PRIVATE PARK for interference.
