MCALLISTER BOYS was on the hip of DASHING for the first six furlongs, rallied two wide to the stretch, battled to mid stretch then edged clear under strong urging. DEAL' EM bobbled slightly at the start then chased the leaders to the second turn, was roused three wide to the stretch then finished steadily and surged past DASHING in the final strides for the place. DASHING contested the pace inside the winner for six furlongs, dug in and fought bravely to deep stretch but weakened in the final stages. MAN OVERBOARD had no speed, raced three wide on the second turn then failed to offer the needed response. GENERAL CAUSEWAY settled for a half mile, bid two wide on the second turn but also was no a threat in the drive. ENUFF BULL saved ground while tracking the pace to the second turn then gave out.
