**Footnotes**

BEST LAID PLANS was permitted to settle early, commenced his bid inside horses on the turn, eased between MR DAY TRIPPER and SUMMER IN DUBLIN entering the lane, shifted out for the drive and was up late. LO'S IN THE FLOW stalked the pace early from the rail, remained inside on the turn to gain command and drew clear, met the winners bid at the furlong but could not quite last. ROCKAWAY MOON lacked early speed, moved up two wide on the turn, dropped inside to rally to the furlong pole then lost his punch. NEWS BEAT was well placed early, became fanned five wide into the lane and did not rally. GLOBAL STORM broke slow and had no speed. SUMMER IN DUBLIN prompted the pace three wide to the stretch and gave out. MR. DAY TRIPPER set the pace from off the rail but stopped after a half mile and was eased in the stretch.
