Footnotes

DARLING CIANA stalked the leaders to the turn, followed DREAM SPOTTER into the stretch inside, shifted out for room in upper stretch then rallied once clear and closed with a surge to be along in time. CRAZY THINKING was on the pace outside of DREAM SPOTTER, dueled two wide to the stretch, inched to the front in mid stretch, dug in gamely late but was tagged on the line. BONDIS SAVIOUR tracked the pace early, was between rivals on the turn then finished willingly through the final furlong. COSMIC ANGEL trailed to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then eased out and finished willingly in the late stages. CAN'T TOPPER was outsprinted early and chased the pace to the turn, got fanned out four deep to the stretch, moved up to loom a threat to mid stretch but could not sustain the needed late response. SCANTILY CLAD (IRE) also tracked the leaders to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch then flattened out in the late going. DREAM SPOTTER was on the pace from the rail to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch then tired.
