Footnotes

KENTUCKY TALE raced up to a short early lead in the opening stages, edged clear from the inside on the turn, responded in the land and held driving. DARNCAT was permitted to settle early, angled to the four path while advancing into the stretch but did not make major impact until the final stages. UNUSUAL JEWEL settled early, saved ground to rally into the stretch but hung in the final sixteenth. CANDY KISSES was well placed outside foes on the backstretch, moved up four wide to the stretch and flattened out. CANUHANDLETHEHEAT prompted the winner from the three path to the stretch and slackened. A. P. ANNA tracked the leaders, was in tight trying to split those rivals into the turn and slipped back. SCENT OF CHRISM raced unhurried early, was in the four path into the stretch and made a late gain. ANNIE EM was void of early speed, saved ground and closed a gap in the late stages without being a serious factor.
