TRAFFIC UPDATE raced up outside into the first turn to prompt the pace to the second turn, remained out and gain command nearing the quarter pole, drew clear to the furlong pole and held driving. GHOST ACTOR raced unhurried early while three wide to the backstretch, advanced two wide on the second turn, cut inside for the drive and finished willingly. MEGABYTE was never far back from between horses, moved closer while three wide on the second turn, bumped with SUNDAY TIMES at the furlong pole and finished evenly. DIAMOND INDY was well positioned from the rail early, continued to save ground on the second turn but lacked the needed response. APOLLO KING trailed to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and finished willingly. ROBERT E set a pressured pace from the rail, slackened once in the stretch then checked off MEGABYTE leaving the furlong pole. SUNDAY TIMES stalked the pace from the outside, remained a factor two wide on the second turn, slackened in the lane then bumped with MEGABYTE near the furlong pole and faltered. DANCING PIONEER showed little. WASSERMAN raced unhurried early from off the rail, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but lacked a response. TIZ US stalked the pace from off the rail early, steadied sharply nearing the half mile pole inside the winner and fell back steadily.
