DAYS OF LIGHTNING broke in stride and dueled for the lead from the rail, edged clear in the upper stretch and held driving. BLAME THE JOCKEY tracked the leaders from the outset, angled four wide nearing the quarter pole, split foes into the lane and finished steadily. ONLY TOP MONEY lagged early, came through inside to the stretch to reach contention and closed well. AFTER REALITY raced close up early from the outside, was fanned six wide into the lane to loose valuable ground then came back on late. SAINTLY I AIN'T was permitted to settle early, raced four wide to the stretch and finished steadily. REGGIE DUNLOP pressed the pace three wide into the stretch and slackened. SHOOT TO THE MOON lacked good early speed and failed to rally while three wide on the turn. GATE TO WIRE settled early, raced two wide to the stretch but did not rally. ALPINE WARRIOR dueled between horses to the head of the lane and gave out.
