Footnotes

ROBS HERO broke alertly but was allowed to settle from the rail, remained inside on the second turn while advancing, eased outside COUNT IT ALL JOY once in the stretch, rallied steadily to gain command late and drew clear driving. COUNT IT ALL JOY prompted the pace two wide throughout, forged to the front near the furlong pole but could not withstand the winner late. CHIEF RUNAWAY lagged early from the rail, commenced his bid from the two path on the second turn, eased out for the drive and finished steadily. SUNDANCE KIDDO set all of the pace from the inside to the upper stretch and weakened. SEE ZO GO stalked the pace two and three wide for six furlongs and failed to rally. MOSCATO was not asked for speed early, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but came up empty.
