IRENES JACKPOT was well placed to the half, rallied two wide to engage for the lead on the second turn, inched away to mid stretch then held under steady urging. HEART'S MUSIC was on the pace on the first turn then was outkicked down the backstretch, bid three wide to the stretch, responded in the drive and finished willingly. LILLY'S A JEWEL was outsprinted early, settled to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch then finished well and just missed second. DYNAMITE RED set a pressured pace to the second turn, dueled with the winner to mid stretch then weakened. TWEETIE PIE broke out and trailed early, was three wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, bid four wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. MAGIC MIMSY tracked the pace early, dropped back on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. NIP OF GOLD had no speed and was never a threat. CATONNIER also had no speed and was always outrun.
