### Footnotes

DIAMOND OF BLUE was rated patiently off the fast early quarter mile, rallied three wide when asked for speed on the turn, pushed past ATTA BOY PETE and drew clear to mid stretch then was kept to task to the line. SUMMER HIT was outrun to the turn, raced two then three wide to the stretch and finished willingly in the final furlong. ATTA BOY PETE had a brief bobble out of the gate but recovered quickly and shot to the front, had a sizable lead to mid turn then came back to the winner to the stretch and tired in the drive. SHADOW BALL had no speed, was out four wide to the stretch then lacked a closing response. EL MARIACHI had no speed and saved ground to no avail.
