ITALIAN RULES dueled in the early stages then sucked back nearing the three eighths pole, remained inside on the turn, rallied when roused into the stretch, pushed to duel leaving the furlong grounds, was headed by the runnerup in deep stretch but fought on bravely for the win. REAGAN REPUBLICAN was outsprinted early and chased the pace, bid two wide to the stretch, rallied to get to terms with the winner leaving the eighth pole, had a nose in front in deep stretch but hung late. HEXBREAKER tracked the pace to the turn, was two wide to mid turn then swung out five wide into the stretch but could not muster a response late. TRIBESMAN was hustled early, dueled outside the winner to the turn, edged away from the two path on the turn, was overcome by rivals in mid stretch then the rider dropped the whip and TRIBESMAN weakened. BLUE JAY ATTACK chased the pace to the turn, tried to rally three deep to the stretch but could not make an impact. HOLLYWOOD DREAMS stalked the pace to the turn, offered his best try three wide to the quarter pole but tired in the drive.
