Footnotes

MY LITTLE MORGAN broke in stride then permitted LADY LOHR to gain the lead in the opening quarter and pressed that rival, rallied two wide into the stretch to gain command at the furlong pole and edged clear driving. EASY GOES BY was permitted to settle early, split horses two wide on the turn and into the stretch and flattened out in the final furlong. SMARTY CORN was forwardly placed early, slipped back from the four path on the turn but responded once in the stretch and finished in a mild rally. LADY LOHR raced up inside to set all of the pace to the furlong pole and weakened. GRASP settled early, saved ground on the turn, remained inside in the upper stretch while trying to lug out, tried to get through tight quarters inside LADY LOHR leaving the furlong pole and steadied then did not recover. SOUL IN ONE lacked early speed, raced in the two path on the turn but had no rally. YERKILLINMESMALLS stalked the pace, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. The rider aboard GRASP lodged an unsuccessful claim of foul against LADY LOHR for interference leaving the furlong pole.
