FAIR WAGER was allowed to settle, began to rally but was forced to circle four wide to the stretch, forged to the lead a furlong out and was under steady pressure to the wire. SMOKIN AFFAIR chased the pace early, bid leaving the half mile pole, rallied three wide to the stretch but was outrun through the drive. EXCESSIVELYCASUAL dueled on the pace to the turn, met the winner's bid to upper stretch then could not keep up late. WICCA stumbled badly to her knees at the start, recovered but was well back early, raced wide to the stretch and finished evenly. MISS PRETTY WOMAN dueled with EXCESSIVELYCASUAL to the turn, stayed on to the quarter pole but gave out through the drive. HIGH AND RISING was allowed to settle, raced three wide to the stretch but lacked a rally. BRITE HORIZON was not a factor. BETHANY GOLD tracked the early pace but weakened on the turn and gave out in the stretch.
