ECHO EDDIE broke alertly and tracked GIBSON COUNTY in the opening quarter while well in hand, dropped to the rail into the turn and advanced to that rival without need of urging, forged to the front at the quarter pole, dueled to inside the furlong then gradually edged away under aggressive hand urging. GIBSON COUNTY was in stride quickly to set all of the pace from off the rail, met the winner's bid mid way on the turn while remaining off the rail, dueled to mid stretch then could not match strides but held well for the place. RADAR CONTACT was permitted to lag early, came through inside on the turn and finished steadily but was never a serious factor. HOOVERGETTHEKEYS raced just outside RADAR CONTACT to the turn, rallied three wide into the stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. EL DORADO SHOOTER stalked the pace three wide to the turn then gave out suddenly.
