SCENT OF CHRISM took a good striking position into the first turn from the three path and was under patient handling to the second turn, offered a quick bid three wide into the stretch to gain command early in the lane then drew clear driving. WILD ICE was permitted to settle early three wide, commenced her bid two wide into the stretch and came on steadily but was no threat to the winner. SARATOGAATSEVENTY raced up four wide into the first turn to be forwardly placed, stalked the pace to the second turn, remained four wide into the lane and went evenly. BY BY INHERITANCE stalked the pace from the inside, challenged on the second turn, led briefly into the stretch and slackened. CAPALATTE saved ground to no avail. BLUE SPARKLE was unhurried early three wide, got fanned four wide on the second turn and did not rally. THE DOLL ROOM was not asked for early speed from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn, steadied sharply into the lane off the heels of CARROW THE SPARROW and did not recover. CARROW THE SPARROW was rank after the start and rushed to a clear early lead from off the rail, maintained an advantage until approaching the quarter pole then had nothing left. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the incident involving THE DOLL ROOM in to the stretch but ruled that CARROW THE SPARROW was at fault and therefore allowed the original finish to stand.
