MACHO DORADO broke alertly then was outsprinted, checked away from CARNIVAL CANDYMAN at the eleven sixteenths pole, bid two wide into the second turn, swung out four deep into the stretch then rallied through the lane and prevailed. NOT IN THIS LIFE stalked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide and engaged for the lead to the stretch, drifted out in upper stretch then straightened, was bumped by CARNIVAL CANDYMAN at the sixteenth marker, could not stall the winner but got the nod for second. CARNIVAL CANDYMAN was hustled to the front while racing off the rail, set the pace to the second turn, responded when headed by the runnerup to the stretch then drifted out leaving mid stretch, bumped with NOT IN THIS LIFE and lost the nod for the place. TRIBAL SKY hesitated in the gate, broke slowly and trailed throughout. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run involving NOT IN THIS LIFE and CARNIVAL CANDYMAN but ruled that the latter initiated the contact and no change was warranted.
