SAMWISE lagged for a half mile, circled rivals four wide on the second turn to loom a factor, seemed to hand in the upper stretch but responded late and gradually got up. CALL TRANSFER settled early and gradually crossed to the rail on the first turn, commenced his bid four wide on the second turn, challenged three wide at the quarter pole, led in the upper stretch but could not hold off the winner late. GRECIAN SPUR pressed the pace from the outset, gained command on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch but was outfinished late. HONOR GULCH saved ground to no avail. MAD ABOUT FUZZ was hustled to the early lead and set the pace from off the rail to the stretch and came up empty. SEEKING THE WINS was never a factor. ANAWKSUNAMIN settled early, raced three wide throughout but failed to respond.
