Footnotes

MR MUNSEY rated kindly for a half mile, bid three wide into the second turn, was fanned five wide to the stretch then finished steadily through the drive without switching leads and drew clear. AERIAL STORM was allowed to settle to the second turn, also was fanned five wide while following the winner into the stretch then could not make an impact while second best. MOMMY GO TOO was a pace factor to the second turn, inched clear but drifted four wide into the stretch, could not stall the winner and weakened to give up the place late. PARKBENCH was also settled to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch but failed to threaten in the late stages. PASTA TIME had no speed and settled, came two wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. HIGH N DEEP had no speed and failed to reach contention then pulled up past the seven eighths pole and was vanned off. WIN IS IN contested the pace for a half mile, was outrun on the second turn and stopped in the stretch.
