MAKE IT A COUGAR showed good speed and dueled three wide to mid turn, kicked away when roused into the stretch then did not switch leads but edged away under urging. LOCKSMITH attended the pace inside the winner to the stretch, was outkicked to mid stretch then weakened but saved second. JESSE'S SOUL tiptoed out of the gate, moved up to chase the pace from the rail to the stretch but went evenly through the final furlong. SIERRA SEVEN tracked the pace to the turn, was three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. WENTZVILLE MAN had no speed, raced off the rail to the stretch then also failed to rally. DR. CHEN tracked the leaders to the turn, was fanned out four wide into the stretch but did not threaten. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM chased the pace to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive. PRE HEAT showed little.
