Footnotes

PRAISE FOR DUBAI rated kindly for five furlongs, was blocked behind rivals on the second turn, eased out into the stretch but still could not find running room, was blocked until inside the furlong marker then angled inward, found clear sailing, dug in determinedly and surged late to get a desperate nod. TOPAKI was allowed to settle for a half, raced three wide to the five sixteenths, shifted out and circled five wide into the stretch then dug in gamely in the final stages but lost a heart-breaking nod. HOT TUB AARON was three wide to the backstretch, chased the leaders to the second turn, got fanned four wide while responding to the stretch, got to terms in mid stretch and fought bravely in the final yards but was nipped. DELAWARE CROSSING was on the pace outside of ALMOST FOOLISH to the second turn, responded to pressure to mid stretch, stayed on gamely late and also just missed. ONE LUCKY GUY tracked the pace for a half mile, bid three wide to the stretch, rallied to join the crowded field on the lead in mid stretch then continued on well to the line. ALMOST FOOLISH was on the pace from the rail for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch then tired.
