**Footnotes**

SCREAMIN EXPRESS settled early in mid pace, advanced inside HELALUE on the turn from the three path, cut inside the leaders nearing the furlong pole and closed steadily to get up in the final strides. DUBAI TAKEOVER broke a bit slow but was quickly in stride and prompting the pace from the outside, moved up three wide on the turn to challenge for command, was carried out into the lane by HI FLYIN STORM, dueled with that rival through the lane to gain a short advantage late but could not stall the winner. HI FLYIN STORM dueled two wide from the outset, drifted to the fourth path into the lane but kept to her task and gave way grudgingly. KELLI O raced unhurried early, came through com the rail on the turn, remained inside and finished steadily. GAMBLERS RULE broke slow and lagged early, raced four wide to the stretch and finished willingly. HELALUE was always forwardly placed, entered the lane outside the winner but could not rally with that rival. SEREFINA showed little. DARNCAT was never a factor. LOVE OUR GRANDKIDS stalked the pace from the rail to the turn and weakened. PERFECTLY SWEET dueled from the rail to mid turn and stopped.
