SKIPSHOT never far back to the second turn, bid between rivals to the stretch then responded when set down for the drive, rallied willingly and was up in time. LIVE SUNDAYS contested the pace to the second turn, responded and edged clear to the stretch then dug in determinedly in the late stages but was tagged late. NORTHERN CAUSEWAY was allowed to settle for a half, saved ground to the stretch then did not threaten the top two. DUNMORE EAST tracked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to loom a threat to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch and came up empty in the final furlong. POSITIVE RESPONSE was on the pace from off the rail to the backstretch, got outrun by the runnerup while saving ground on the second turn and tired in mid stretch. AUTISM AWARENESS had no speed, bid three then four wide to the stretch but lacked a response in the drive.
