SADLER'S COURT was off a step slow then allowed to settle in stride, saved ground through the second turn, angled out into the lane, responded to steady urging and wore down the dueling pair in the closing yards. HONEY DUEX stalked the pace of HAPPY RAINBOW from the outside, moved up to engage that rival with a sixteenth to run, vied through a vigorous drive but could not resist the winner from over the top. HAPPY RAINBOW sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by HONEY DUEX nearing the sixteenth marker but could not hold the winner off late. HELM'S MAGIC broke sharply then raced just off the leaders, moved outside through the second turn and lacked the needed closing response. TIZ TRUE LOVE lugged out through the first turn, raced off the pacesetters soon after, moved outside through the second turn and failed to rally in the drive. DAN'S PLAN B was never far back while racing along the inside and gradually gave way. RISING ABOVE steadied soon after the start and lagged throughout.
