BOTTLE BLONDE (GB) was never far back while racing along the inside, waited for racing room nearing the quarter, found room with a furlong to run and proved best through the final yards. VICTORIA SHINES was away alertly to duel for the early advantage with CRAZY ABOUT HIM, disposed of that rival in mid-stretch but could not hold the winner safe late. CRAZY ABOUT HIM broke sharply to dispute the pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. MILLIE'S TOPPER chased the leaders from between foes, lacked racing room nearing the quarter and finished evenly when clear. GLORIOUS VALENTINE hopped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. TRAIN FREEZE raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout, tied up after crossing the wire and was walked off. BESAME MUCHO chased the leaders from the outside for a half and weakened. LEESON STREET showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
