Footnotes

BOBBY HANDY was never far back while racing along the inside, pulled to contend under steady restraint nearing the nine-sixteenths marker, angled out into the stretch, reached DIXICO inside the furlong marker and proved best over that rival through the final yards. DIXICO broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail, could not resist the winner in the drive but held on with good determination. TITIAN was away alertly to chase the leaders from between foes, dropped back slightly through the second turn, angled out approaching the stretch and finished with good late energy. NATIVE THUNDER was never far back, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths pole, stayed on in the drive and finished willingly. MICHAEL THE MAN was off a step slow then hustled along to press the pace from the outside and gradually gave way after going three-quarters. STORMY SURGE was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. MUSIC APPEAL showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and was not a factor.
