DEMON WARLOCK prompted the pace to the turn, came two wide and rallied to the lead in upper stretch, edged clear then held under steady urging. MR JOE B tracked the pace from the rail to mid turn, shifted out and rallied three wide into the stretch then closed steadily to the line. DANCE WITH PRIDE was allowed to settle, saved ground to the stretch and was gaining late. BEST ON TAP had the best speed and set the early pace, was caught and dueled the winner to the stretch but tired in the drive. MOVEINDAY never far back to the turn, got fanned four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. SHADOW RAIDER had no speed, saved ground on the turn but came up empty in the drive. GRANDPA CHAN had no speed, was forced to angle out five wide to avoid WINDSCORE mid turn and was outrun. WINDSCORE tracked the pace to the turn then went wrong mid turn and was pulled up and vanned off.
