BIG HONEY BEE broke in stride and set all of the pace under a snug hold to the stretch, responded when set down and held gamely. UNBRIDLED JOULE was permitted to settle early, raced two wide into the stretch, rallied to the sixteenth pole then lost some of her punch. TABLE FOR ONE raced unhurried early, was two wide to the stretch, shifted out while splitting rivals leaving the three sixteenth pole, got the outside a furlong out and finished steadily. PURE STORM tracked the winner from the rail into the stretch and failed to respond. LAFAYETTE STAR lagged early, came three wide to the stretch and closed too late. STYLIN JULIE bobbled slightly at the start and settled, was fanned four wide to the stretch but did not rally. INDIAN CHARLIZE prompted the winner for a half mile then came up empty.
