Footnotes

BERT' N THE GROUP was unhurried to the second turn, rallied three then four wide to the stretch, got to terms a furlong out, battled the runnerup to deep stretch then inched away in the final yards. COLOURSOFTHEGLEN (IRE) hopped at the start then recovered and stalked the leaders to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, dueled the winner through the final furlong and was bested late. EDDIE CODDANA settled inside for a half mile, remained inside on the second turn, responded in upper stretch but was bumped by RED SEA and had to check briefly at the three sixteenths then continued on gamely late. PUMP N UP was outrun to the second turn, raced four wide to the stretch then was widest in the drive and finished willingly. MUTINY BAY contested the pace inside of STORY BEHIND IT for six furlongs, drifted out slightly and crowded RED SEA at the three sixteenths then tired through the final furlong. RED SEA had no speed and settled for a half, was two wide while waiting for room to develop to the stretch, tried to rally between rivals in upper stretch but was crowded by MUTINY BAY, steadied and bumped with EDDIE CODDANA then lost his punch. STORY BEHIND IT was on the pace outside of MUTINY BAY for six furlongs but tired in mid stretch.
