Footnotes

DOWNTOWN C. T. stalked the leaders to the turn, bid two wide to mid turn, eased out three wide into the stretch, rallied to engage for the lead, edged away to deep stretch then held off the late run of JOHNSKI. The latter was outsprinted to the turn, got fanned four wide while rallying to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch then finished willingly in a fine debut. ELMOR was on the pace early then dropped away nearing the turn, bid three then four wide to the stretch, loomed to mid stretch but flattened out late. GERMANY BAY was on the pace outside of TRIBAL PRIZE to the stretch, briefly resisted the winner to mid stretch then tired. MINOU'S TOPPER chased the pace to the turn, was three wide to mid turn then got fanned out six wide to the stretch, had to check away from the runnerup when that one angled out leaving the three sixteenths and failed to make a late bid. PROSPERO was outsprinted early and chased the leaders to the turn, was forced out five wide to the stretch then also lacked a closing response. TRIBAL PRIZE was hustled and dueled from the rail to the stretch then stopped.
