PUMPKIN PIE was allowed to settle early, angled for outside nearing the quarter, reached the fore with a furlong to run, quickly drew off and was in hand late. DYNAMITE RED showed no early speed, circled up five wide to offer a bid nearing the quarter, gained a slight advantage but was no match for the winner in the drive. A. P. ANNA was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way through the final quarter. UNUSUAL JEWEL raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, angled out further into the lane, could not gain on the leaders in the drive but showed some late interest. SATIN BOUQUET was never far back, moved up from the outside to launch her bid nearing the quarter but failed to sustain her rally in the drive. BLUE SPARKLE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after going three-quarters. CAJUN MARKET was pulled up after going a half, bled and was vanned off.
