Footnotes

FIST PUMP was stalking the pace between rivals in the opening quarter, had to steady when caught off heels leaving the half mile pole, dropped back to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then finished with a strong run in the final furlong. STORMING KENTUCKY was a pace factor to the turn, dueled inside to the stretch, responded to steady urging through the drive but could not hold off the winner. SECRET SPY had good early speed, dueled two wide to the stretch, responded to deep stretch then was outfinished. CLASSIC CRUSADER had no speed, trailed to the turn, was three then four wide to the stretch and made steady progress in the drive. SHADOW BALL was also stalking the leaders to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then failed to rally in the drive. D'WILDBUNCH tracked the pace to the turn, tried to rally from the three path to the stretch but gave way in the lane.
