LANG FIELD was used for speed and pushed clear into the first turn, settled on the front end to the second turn, turned back the runnerup in mid stretch and held determinedly. JIMMY DA BRICK chased the winner for a half mile, edged clear while three wide on the second turn, loomed to mid stretch then was outfinished to the line. SACRED LIGHT was outrun for a half mile, saved ground while gaining some on the second turn but could not make an impact late. JOE CARL trailed to the second turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch while also making progress then lost his punch leaving mid stretch. SEA OF MARMARA was also outrun to the half, bid two wide to the stretch then flattened out.
