OFF KILTER stalked the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, dug in when set down in mid stretch and wore down the leader late. REAGAN REPUBLICAN set all the pace under pressure to the stretch, responded to deep stretch then could not stall the winner. SIX PACK ABS was settled to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then finished willingly in the final furlong. GO BAROQUE was crowded by CASTLE DERMOT leaving the chute and checked, was outrun to the turn, got fanned five wide to the stretch then was also gaining in the final furlong. SCHRAMSBERG prompted the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch but lost his punch through the final furlong. CASTLE DERMOT bore out nearing the end of the chute and crowded GO BAROQUE, settled to the turn, was four wide to the stretch then made a late gain without threatening. FU PEG HE RAT had no speed, bid three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. ROYAL MANGO tracked the pace from the rail to the stretch but was outfinished in the drive. WIND SHIFTER was forced out leaving the chute, had no speed then was forced six wide into the stretch and weakened through the lane.
