APPEALING RESUME broke alertly then was permitted to slip back, advanced three wide on the turn, came to the outside for the drive and closed steadily to gain command late and won driving. DINNR WITH NIKKI C pressed CRAZY THINKING for the lead from the outside throughout, was fanned to the four path by that rival into the lane, continued to respond, took command in the deep stretch but could not hold. CRAZY THINKING set all of the pace from off the rail, drifted to the three path into the lane and gradually weakened. TALLAHSOCEAN was well placed just off the leaders, saved ground to rally into the stretch, had her best bid at the furlong pole then flattened out. RUCKUSING STORM was never too far back, raced two wide on the turn but failed to rally. VICTORIOUSLY settled early, raced four wide on the turn then did not respond in a dull effort. CRAZY TRICIA was never a factor.
