### Footnotes

BIG TIME SUNSHINE prompted the leader for five furlongs, rallied three wide on the second turn, got to terms a furlong out, could not shake loose but dug in determinedly to get the nod. RUBY PUMPS rated on the front end for a half, responded to pressure on the second turn, met the winner's bid, gamely resisted to deepest stretch but lost a tough photo. SINGLE N LOVIN IT was allowed to settle for a half, got fanned four wide while rallying on the second turn, loomed a threat to mid stretch but was outfinished late. ASTUZIA stalked the leader to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then finished steadily but did not make a late impact. REAL ROCKPORT was settled in the early stages, tried to rally while three deep on the second turn but came up empty in the drive.
