Footnotes

YUOGOTTAWANNA broke cleanly then was permitted to settle from just off the rail, eased outside for a clear path leaving the half mile pole, began his rally once on the second turn, came three wide and inside CAPPUCHINO nearing the quarter pole to reach serious contention, continued to respond in the lane, collared DANTHEBLUEGRASSMAN in mid stretch to win driving. DANTHEBLUEGRASSMAN prompted the pace from the outset, advanced two wide on the second turn to challenge for command, the rider dropped his whip entering the stretch with a clear lead, then the jockey quickly snatched off his goggles nearing the furlong pole and used them as a whip but they could not stall the winner. LUSTY LATIN lagged far back to the second turn, angled out quickly at mid turn, came to the extreme outside for the drive and finished full of run. ARSEN raced unhurried while dropping to the rail into the first turn, advanced gradually on the backstretch, remained inside to the stretch, shifted out to loom a factor in the upper stretch, finished steadily but lost much of his punch late. DIAL A HERO lacked early speed, raced three wide much of the way and passed only tiring horses. FEBRUARY STORM stalked the pace from the inside to the stretch then came up empty when called upon. CAPTAIN SQUIRE set all of the pace from just off the rail to midway on the second turn and had little response when headed. CAPPUCHINO prompted the pace from the outset, offered a menacing bid outside once on the second turn, drifted four wide into the lane and gave out. LETHAL GRANDE tracked the pace to the second turn and gave out. NIGHT PASSION (GB) lacked good early speed, was wide throughout and never serious threatened.
