Footnotes

PAPASILPRINCESS was settled for a half mile, rallied four wide under urging on the second turn, moved to engage the leaders to mid stretch then battled on late and inched away in the final yards. EGYPTIAN FEMME set a pressured pace for six furlongs, responded to urging in the stretch, dug in determinedly but could not stall the winner while holding off DANGEROUS AFFAIR for second. DANGEROUS AFFAIR eased outside the runnerup before reaching the first turn, pressed that one through six furlongs while two wide, responded when set down for the drive but could not get by and was outfinished. PAWN SHOP had no speed, bid three three then four wide on the second turn but could not make an impact. SUPERCILIOUS was caught out five deep into the first turn turn, took back a step and shifted down to the three path, settled to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch then failed to offer the needed late response. PACIFIC COAST settled mid pack for a half, saved ground on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. SUNFLARE stalked the leaders to the second turn, rallied three wide while inside the winner to the quarter pole but could not keep up after that.
