BENCH LIGHT lagged early from off the rail, moved closer into the second turn, circled rivals six wide into the stretch, offered a bold rally to gain command in mid stretch and drew clear while drifting in slightly. MCALLISTER BOYS stalked the leaders three wide from the outset, rallied into the stretch to challenge for command at the furlong pole then checked slightly off the winner while coming out in the final stages. MACHO BULL settled from the rail, moved up into the second turn to be four wide into the stretch, offered his bid at the furlong pole and was outfinished. WORLDLY LAD was hustled from the gate to gain command into the first turn, set the pace from off the rail, dropped inside on the second turn and slackened in the lane. MAGICO settled early, raced two wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. SILVER TERRACE lacked early speed, offered his best bid five wide on the second turn but lost his punch in the lane. C C'S DIAMOND was hard used early to press the pace from the rail to the second turn and stopped. The jockey aboard MCALLISTER BOYS lodged an objection against the winner for interference nearing the finish. The stewards ruled that incident did not effect the final finish
