Footnotes

SNOWBOUND MARQUITA had the best speed, set the pace from the rail to the stretch, kicked away to mid stretch then was kept to task to the line. TIZANNETTE pressed the winner two wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch then dug in late to save second. TRUFFLE N PARADISE was outsprinted to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then was no threat to the winner but dug in late and got the nod for the show. PEEK A BOOP broke alertly then was outsprinted early, stalked the winner three wide to the stretch, lacked the needed closing response but battled late for third and just missed. CAPITAL MISS had no speed, raced three wide on the turn but came up empty in the drive. A LITTLE POLISH was a brief factor to the turn, dropped back to the stretch then was eased in mid stretch but walked off.
