AWESOME JARED was settled to the half mile pole, rallied three wide into the second turn, got fanned four wide while gaining to the stretch, edged away to mid stretch and held under steady pressure. TIME TO HONOR attended the pace to the second turn, saved ground and responded to urging to the stretch then was overtaken by the winner in upper stretch but saved second. OHMYOHMY had no speed, saved ground on the second turn then eased out for room and was making progress late. ON TIME FLIGHT had no speed, got fanned four wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed response. PAT'S LEGACY stumbled badly at the start and almost unseated his rider, hustled up to attend the pace early, settled in the third position to the second turn, offered his best bid three wide on the second turn but gave way in the drive. DEACON SPEAKIN' alternated on the lead with TIME TO HONOR to the second turn but stopped after six furlongs. SUDDEN EXCESS was settled for a half mile, had nothing to offer when asked into the second turn then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
