MOONS PRIDE raced up and gain command into the first turn, was engaged by SWISS EDITOR M D on the backstretch, dueled throughout with that rival, bumped late and just held in a head bob decision. SWISS EDITOR M D pressed the winner from the outside throughout, bumped with that rival late and just missed after the prolonged duel. GREEK ANGELS settled early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn, came out for room in the stretch, bumped with FISHING MY WAY then outfinished that rival for the show. FISHING MY WAY was not asked for speed early from off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, was bumped by GREEK ANGEL leaving the three sixteenths pole and slackened. REFORMED raced unhurried early, saved ground throughout and did not rally. LIGHTNINGFASTMAN was void of any early speed and passed only tiring horses. PICASSO BLUE stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and gave way. AKOYA BEACH settled early three wide, came four wide to the stretch but had no response. ZANDA'S SECRET was forwardly early, got fanned four wide on the second turn and gave way, the stewards entertained two claims of foul. The rider aboard FISHING MY WAY claimed foul against GREEK ANGEL for interference in the upper stretch, and while they acknowledged the bumping incident, ruled that it did not effect the outcome. And the rider aboard SWISS EDITOR M D claimed foul against the winner but the stewards ruled that bumping was mutual and allowed the original finish to stand.
