PEBBLE BEACH BABY was well positioned from the outset, advanced three wide on the turn to gain command in the upper stretch and won driving. RUN SOPHIA RUN prompted the pace two wide, challenged in the upper stretch but was outfinished. YA WANNA HUG Set the pace from the inside and held well for the show. HOLLANITA raced unhurried early, came four wide to the stretch and closed too late. JEWEL S. stalked from the rail into the stretch but lacked the needed response. BLUE BLIZZARD steadied sharply at the start and lost her best chance. MARMARIS settled early then came up empty while two wide into the stretch.
