OLYMPIC BLUE raced up into the first turn to take a good striking position, rallied two wide to gain command at the quarter pole then edged clear to the furlong pole and held driving. THERE GOES DONNIE raced unhurried early from the rail, responded from the two path into the lane to loom a factor but hung in the drive. MOJAVE HEAT lagged early off the rail, offered a menacing bid by circling rivals four wide into the stretch then lost his punch. HARLAN'S HALO was well placed early two wide, eased three wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. TRIBAL MONEY gain command once on the first turn and set the pace under restraint but had little left after six furlongs. BEAU DIABLO saved ground to no avail. SEEKING THE STITCH had no speed.
