PLANET SUNSHINE had good speed, dueled outside a rival to the stretch, inched away to mid stretch then was collared by the runnerup but battled gamely under vigorous handling and fought back stubbornly to get the decision. CROWN OVER hesitated momentarily, broke a bit slow then was bumped on both sides in the chute, hustled to gain a tracking position to the turn, bid two wide to mid turn then angled three wide into the stretch, rallied steadily to get to terms in deep stretch then hung in the final strides. OVER THE BUDGET had no speed, raced off the rail and outside a foe to the stretch and made up ground belatedly. COME AWAY HOME stalked the leaders to the turn, bid three wide to mid turn, was forced out four wide into the stretch and weakened leaving mid stretch. BEST LAID PLANS had no speed and saved ground to no avail. JEFFREY'S GROOVE was quickest from the chute and angled over to the rail, dueled inside to the stretch then was outkicked to mid stretch and tired.
