Footnotes

WOODFORD PRINCESS was permitted to lag to the second turn, quickly circled rivals five wide into the lane, forged to the front leaving the furlong pole and proved best driving. MOVING EXPERIENCE (IRE) tracked the pace three wide from the outset, moved to challenge into the stretch, forged to the front at the furlong pole but was outfinished by the winner in the final furlong. CATCHIN SOME RAYS raced unhurried early, advanced just inside the winner once on the second turn, was caught behind MY RUBY CHARM at the quarter pole and forced to steady sharply, dropped inside for room but had to maneuver back outside nearing the furlong pole then closed a gap in the late stages. VICTORIA'S GARDEN tracked the pace three wide to the stretch, challenged nearing the furlong pole but slackened in the final furlong. MY RUBY CHARM (NZ) was permitted to settle within easy striking distance early from the inside, became boxed behind the leaders at the half pole and lacked room continuously into the stretch, tried to get through inside CONTINENTAL WINE at mid stretch but was forced to steady repeatedly then found room much too late. CONTINENTAL WINE pressed the pace two wide, challenged for command on the second turn, led briefly in the upper stretch then gradually slackened. CAPTAIN'S SURPRISE was never a serious factor. FLYINDOWNBAYLAUREL set the pace from the inside to the stretch and came up empty.
