MISSISSIPPI GOLD took back at the start and lagged to the second turn, came through inside SURF TOWN at the five sixteenths to quickly reach contention, shifted to the extreme outside for the drive, rallied to the lead at the sixteenth pole and drew clear driving. BARON'S GOLD alternated on the lead outside DARK MATTER for six furlongs, edged clear in the upper stretch but could not stall the winner. BODACAT was permitted to settle early from the rail, advanced from the two path into the stretch to loom a factor but hung in the final furlong. MERRY MARINO broke alertly but settled from the rail and tracked the dueling leaders, eased out three wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. DARK MATTER dueled from the rail to the head of the lane and came up empty. SURF TOWN raced in mid pack to the second turn then failed to respond from the two path after six furlongs. WIN TO WIN was always outrun.
